SpaceX sends NASA astronauts to space center

these guys know what to expect," you know?

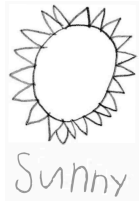
The rest of this story is rocket science that I do not understand, but is really cool. I hoped you enjoyed the article!

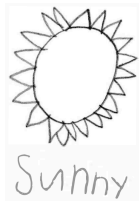

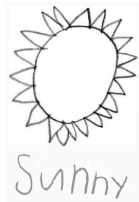

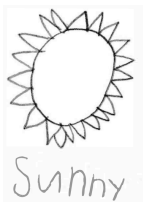

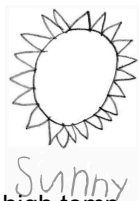

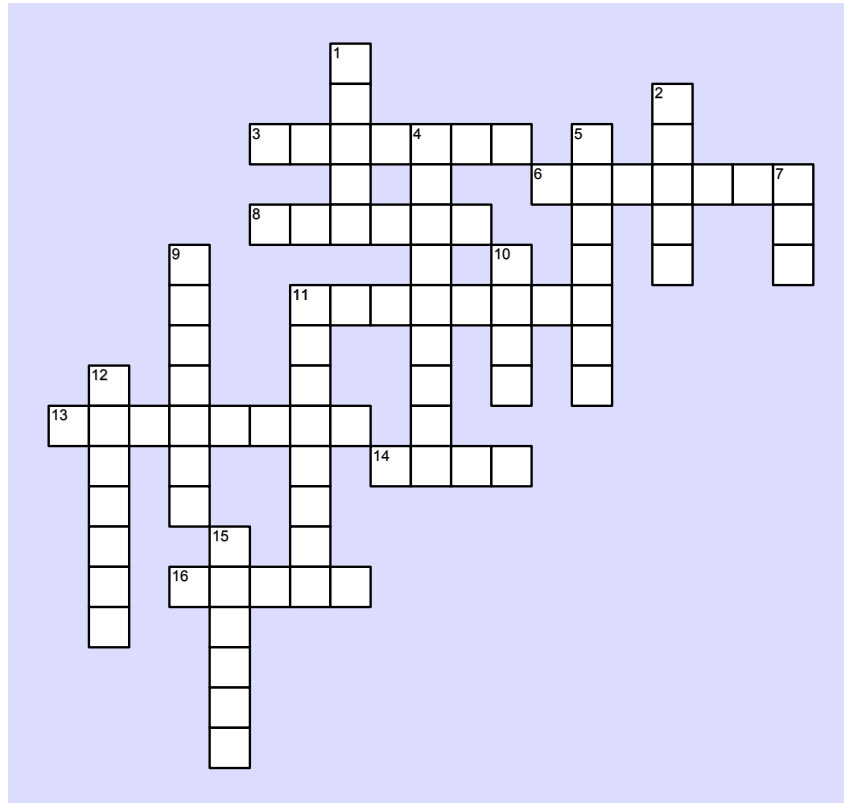

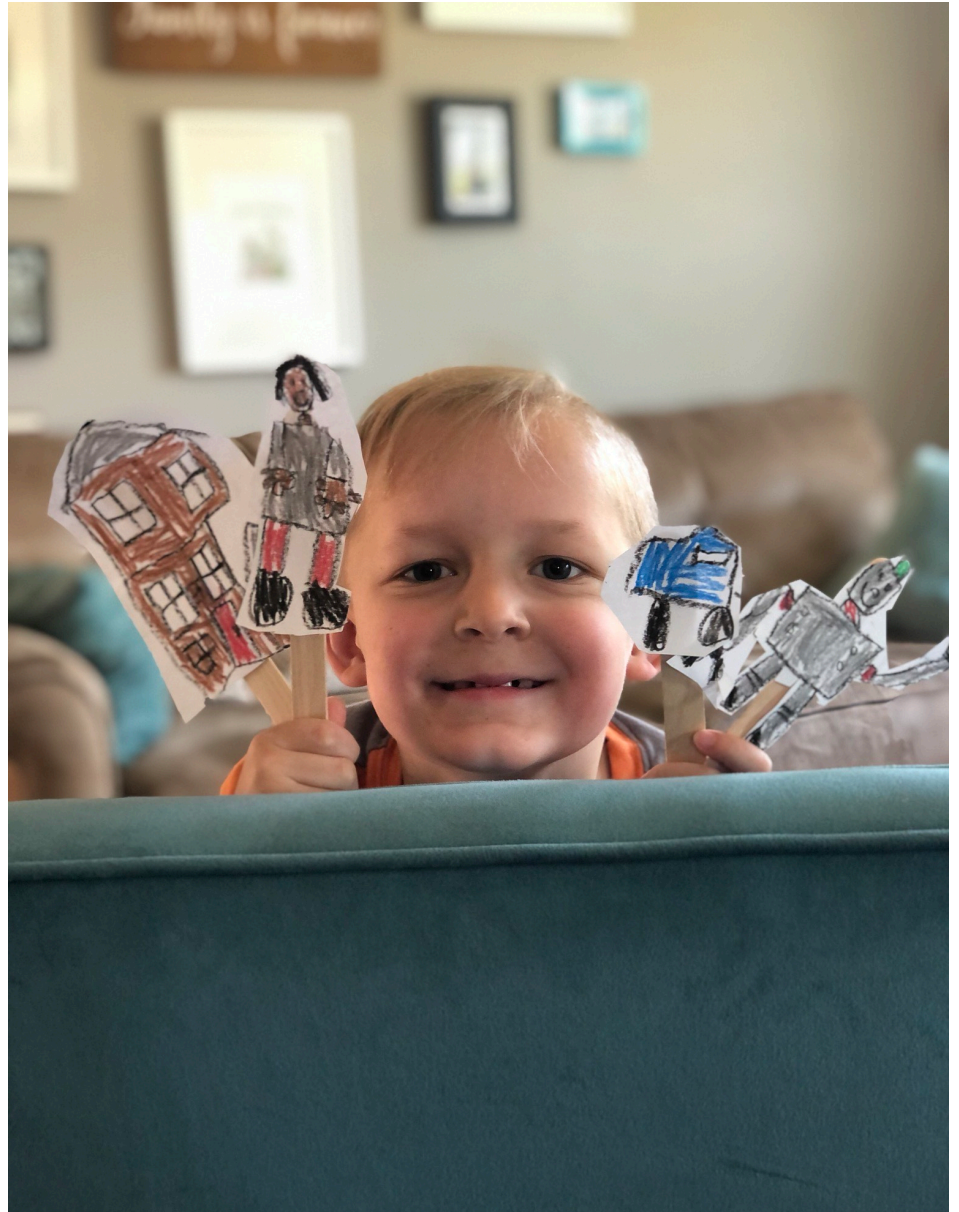
